Dear Parent or Guardian,

According to the Ohio Law, students enrolled in grades K-12 are required to present written proof that they have been immunized against the following list of diseases.

In reviewing your child's records, we find that there is no written proof of immunizations for those items circled below.

DPT 1	Polio 1	MMR1	Varicella 1	Hepatitis B 1
DPT 2	Polio 2	MMR2	Varicella 2	Hepatitis B 2
DPT 3	Polio 3	MCV4 #1	T Dap	Hepatitis B 3
DPT 4	Polio 4	MCV4 #2	Booster

The fourth DPT must have been given on or after the child's fourth birthday. If not, a 5th DPT must be given. The fourth Polio must have been given on or after the child's fourth birthday. If not, a 5th Polio must be given. Immunization against measles (Rubeola) and mumps (MMR 1) must have been given on or after the child's first birthday and measles (Rubeola) and mumps (MMR 2) must have been given at least 28 days after dose one. Immunization against Hepatitis 1, 2, and 3 must be given before kindergarten. Varicella is the vaccination required for chickenpox.

A written record of the exact date (month, day, year) of immunization for each of the diseases checked above must be brought or sent to your child's school before **Thursday, September 30, 2016**. According to state law, failure to provide such written record will result in your child's EXCLUSION FROM SCHOOL as of that date.

If you have a philosophical/religious objection, or your student's physician has a medical objection, the immunization exemption form must be completed and returned to your student's school. Forms are available in your school's main office. Immunization vaccines can be obtained from a physician, or they may be obtained from the Stark County Health Department.
